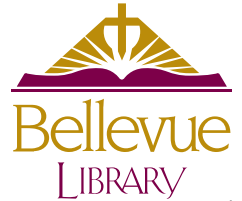

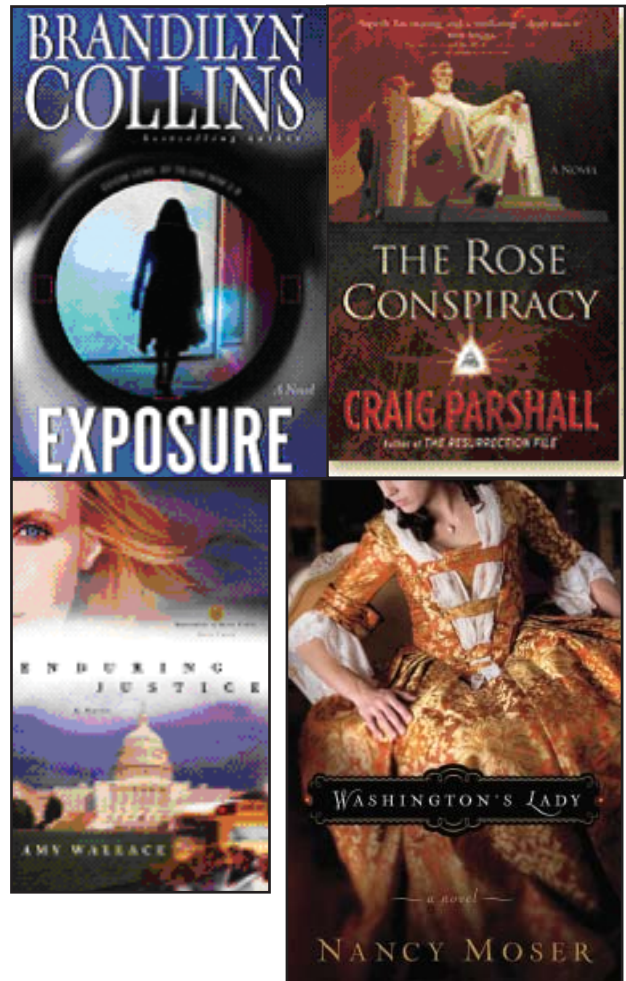

Bad Manners in God's House

The following excerpt is from the book by Richard W. Lewis written in 1917.

Bad Manner #12: Miscellaneous Misconduct of the Church Itself (part one)

Perhaps it will not be amiss to carry this discussion of bad Church manners a little further, leaving the individual to take up the congregation, for there are congregational wrong-doings as well as those of the individual members.

One of the most scathing denunciations that ever fell from the Master's lips, so far as the record goes, was in connection with the misuse of the house of God. Our Churches have been solemnly dedicated to God. Surely we should not allow them to be desecrated by secular uses. But what shall we say of public gatherings far from religious, being allowed in the Church? Why should God's house be used for a lecture hall? Why should the house of God be used for any purposes for which attendants must pay from a dime to a dollar? Why should we, any more than the Jews of old, make "my Father's

house a place of merchandise?" Is it any wonder that so many Churches have "a name to live" twelve long months in the year without a single convert?

God Himself teaches us that the great end and aim of the Church is the second birth. Then how dare we resolve the Church into a social club, or a religious "order?" Such charges are daily made against the Church of the living God. How can we be honest with ourselves and deny that we have given cause for such charges?
