Disciple Making Process

- Week 2: **John 8:31-32**
So Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, “If you continue in My word, *then* you are truly disciples of Mine; ³²and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free.”
- Week 3: **2 Timothy 2:2**
The things which you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, entrust these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.
- Week 4: **Matthew 28:18-20**
And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, ²⁰teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”
- Week 5: **Ephesians 4:11-12**
And He gave some *as* apostles, and some *as* prophets, and some *as* evangelists, and some *as* pastors and teachers, ¹²for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ;
- Week 6: **I Timothy 4:7-8**
But have nothing to do with worldly fables fit only for old women. On the other hand, discipline yourself for the purpose of godliness; ⁸for bodily discipline is only of little profit, but godliness is profitable for all things, since it holds promise for the present life and *also* for the *life* to come.
- Week 7: **Matthew 7:7**
“Ask, and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.”
- Week 8: **2 Timothy 2:15**
Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.
- Week 9: **John 14:15**
“If you love Me, you will keep My commandments.”
- Week 10: **Psalms 119:11**
Your word I have treasured in my heart, That I may not sin against You.
- Week 11: **Jeremiah 15:16**
Your words were found and I ate them, And Your words became for me a joy and the delight of my heart; For I have been called by Your name, O LORD God of hosts.
- Week 12: **John 3:16**
“For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.”
Romans 3:23
“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

- Week 13: **Romans 6:23**
“For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”
1 Corinthians 15:3-4
“Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures...He was buried...He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures.”
- Week 14: **2 Corinthians 6:2**
“Behold, now is ‘the acceptable time,’ behold, now is ‘the day of salvation.’”
Luke 13:3
“Unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.”
- Week 15: **Acts 17:30**
“God is now declaring to men that all people everywhere should repent.”
Acts 16:31
“Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household.”
- Week 16: **Romans 10:9**
“That if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved.”
- Week 17: **John 1:12**
“But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name.”
Romans 10:13
“Whoever will call upon the name of the Lord will be saved.”
- Week 18: **Mark 1:35**
In the early morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left *the house*, and went away to a secluded place, and was praying there.
- Week 19: **James 5:16**
Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.
- Week 20: **John 15:7**
If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.
- Week 21: **1 John 5:14-15**
This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. ¹⁵ And if we know that He hears us *in* whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.
- Week 22: **1 Corinthians 4:1-2**
Let a man regard us in this manner, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.
² In this case, moreover, it is required of stewards that one be found trustworthy.

- Week 23: **John 4:23-24**
“But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers. ²⁴God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”
- Week 24: **Mark 10:45**
“For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.”
- Week 25: **Amos 3:3**
Can two walk together, except they be agreed?
- Week 26: **Proverbs 27:17**
Iron sharpens iron, So one man sharpens another.
- Week 27: **Ephesians 4:27**
and do not give the devil an opportunity.
- Week 28: **James 4:7- 8**
Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. ⁸Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.
- Week 29: **Ephesians 6:10**
Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might.
- Week 30: **Ephesians 6:11**
Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil.
- Week 31: **Ephesians 6:12**
For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual *forces* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*.
- Week 32: **Ephesians 6:13-14**
Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm. ¹⁴Stand firm therefore, HAVING GIRDED YOUR LOINS WITH TRUTH, and HAVING PUT ON THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS,
- Week 33: **Ephesians 6:15-16**
and having shod YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE; ¹⁶in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil *one*.
- Week 34: **Ephesians 6:17-18**
And take THE HELMET OF SALVATION, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. ¹⁸With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints,

- Week 35: **Ephesians 6:19-20**
and *pray* on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel, ²⁰for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in *proclaiming* it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.
- Week 36: **Ezekiel 22:30**
I searched for a man among them who would build up the wall and stand in the gap before Me for the land, so that I would not destroy it; but I found no one.
- Week 37: **I Corinthians 11:1**
Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ.
- Week 38: **I Timothy 4:15**
Take pains with these things; be *absorbed* in them, so that your progress will be evident to all.
- Week 39: **Romans 15:14**
And concerning you, my brethren, I myself also am convinced that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able also to admonish one another.
- Week 40: **Proverbs 5:21-23**
For the ways of a man are before the eyes of the LORD, And He watches all his paths. ²²His own iniquities will capture the wicked, And he will be held with the cords of his sin. ²³He will die for lack of instruction, And in the greatness of his folly he will go astray.
- Week 41: **Luke 14:26-27**
“If anyone comes to Me, and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be My disciple. ²⁷Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple.”
- Week 42: **Hebrews 11:6**
And without faith it is impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and *that* He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.
- Week 43: **Romans 4:19-21**
Without becoming weak in faith he contemplated his own body, now as good as dead since he was about a hundred years old, and the deadness of Sarah’s womb; ²⁰yet, with respect to the promise of God, he did not waver in unbelief but grew strong in faith, giving glory to God, ²¹and being fully assured that what God had promised, He was able also to perform.
