

**Week of January 29: Abram Obeyed God**  
**Genesis 12:1–20**

**ASK interactive questions.**

1. What are the most important items to pack for a long trip?
2. How did Abram respond to God's instructions? Do you think that was hard or easy for him? Why?
3. How do we know what God wants us to do?

**BRING your understanding.**

Share one thing you learned about Abram obeying God's directions from your adult Life Group lesson.

**CREATE fun experiences.**

Activity: That's Impossible!

Supplies: Resealable plastic sandwich bag, water, and sharpened pencils

Instruct your child to fill a plastic sandwich bag halfway with water. Afterward, hold up the bag and ask, "Who believes I can poke a pencil through the bag without any water coming out?" Let each family member answer and give the reasons for their answers. Then, dramatically poke the pencil through the bag and amaze your kids that no water poured out! Once the pencil sticks through both sides of the bag, leave it there. (Be sure to practice beforehand.) Allow your children the opportunity to poke pencils through the bag, too.

Read Genesis 21:1–3 to your family. Explain that God's directions seem impossible sometimes, but if we obey, He will help us every step of the way.
