

**Week of January 22: Noah and the Ark**  
**Genesis 6:5–7:10**

**ASK interactive questions.**

1. What is your favorite part of the story of Noah building the ark?
2. Did Noah obey or disobey God's directions concerning the ark? Why is that important?
3. Obeying God's directions can be difficult. What is an instruction from the Bible that you struggle to follow? Why is it hard to obey that instruction?

**BRING your understanding.**

Share one thing you learned about Noah building the ark from your adult Life Group lesson.

**CREATE fun experiences.**

Activity: Test Noah's Memory

Supplies: None

Have your family sit around the dining room table or on the floor in a circle. The first person will say, "Noah forgot what animals he took on the ark. He took a \_\_\_\_\_." (Say the name of an animal.) The second person will repeat what the first person said and add a second animal. Go several rounds to see how many animals your family can remember.

Read Genesis 6:17–22 to your family. Remind them that Noah obeyed every instruction God gave, and, because of his obedience, his family was saved.
