

Week of January 8: Creation/God Made the World
Genesis 1–2

ASK interactive questions.

1. Of everything God created, what do you wish you could have seen Him create? Why?
2. What is something new you learned about God after learning about Creation?
3. Why do you think God gave Adam work to do in the Garden of Eden?

BRING your understanding.

Share one thing you learned about Creation in Genesis 1 from your adult Life Group lesson.

CREATE fun experiences.

Activity: Family Skit of Creation

Supplies: Various items from around your house

Tell your family that each person will help tell the story of Creation. Assign a day of Creation to each family member (some members may get more than one day). Instruct them to find items from around your house to help them share what God created on their assigned day. Give everyone enough time to find their items or create any needed props. Afterward, allow everyone to present their day of Creation.

Days of Creation:

Day 1 – Light (Genesis 1:3–5)

Day 2 – Sky (Genesis 1:6–8)

Day 3 – Land, plants, and trees (Genesis 1:9–13)

Day 4 – Sun, moon, and stars (Genesis 1:14–19)

Day 5 – Fish and birds (Genesis 1:20–23)

Day 6 – Animals and people (Genesis 1:24–31)

Day 7 – God rested. (Genesis 2:1–4)
