



Course Title: Algebra 1 MUS (Math U See)

Description:

In this 32 week course, students will learn and practice specific algebra skills in a logical, systematic sequence to help students learn how to solve math problems and discover why they are solved in that method. Topics covered will include graphing, simultaneous equations, exponents, polynomials, and solving for an unknown with one variable.

The Algebra 1 MUS course will utilize the popular and built for homeschool Math-U-See curriculum in addition to instructor-provided supplemental material to reinforce specific topics and traditionally difficult concepts.

Upon completion of this course, students will be prepared to advance to Geometry.

Homework Expectations: Approximately 30-45 minutes per day (Monday – Friday)

Recommended Grades: 8+

Prerequisites: Pre-algebra or equivalent. Must be proficient with multiplication facts 1 to 12 and with basic math skills relating to fractions.
