



Course Title: Geometry MUS (Math-U-See)

Description:

In this 32 week course, students will learn and practice logic and analytical skills through exercises in Geometry. Topics covered will include working with points, lines, planes, and other basic geometric figures; angles, arcs, and circles; right triangles, proofs and reasoning.

The Geometry course will utilize the popular and built for homeschool Math-U-See curriculum in addition to instructor-provided supplemental material to reinforce specific topics and traditionally difficult concepts.

Upon completion of this course, students will be prepared to advance to Algebra 2.

Homework Expectations: Approximately 30-45 minutes per day (Monday – Friday)

Recommended Grades: 10+

Prerequisites: Algebra 1
