Go! Jr. K5 at Bellevue Tutorial

A homeschool program geared for the Kindergarten mind.

Kindergarten is a foundational year for building mental and social skills in your young learner. K5 Kindergarten in Go! Jr. is a once-a-week academic day out of the home for your homeschooler to help develop a love of learning and exercise early social skills. Go Jr. supplements the K5 homeschooling your student is doing elsewhere to offer a critical first year of classroom participation, social interaction, and diverse experiences to help guide young students as they make assumptions about learning and apply those to their daily lives. The Go! enrichment program provides students with a safe community for fun and learning. At the end of a successful year in Go! Jr. students move forward to the next level, confident and ready.

Go! Jr. – A Full Day Program

You are reading that correctly. The Go! Jr. day runs concurrent with the popular Go! Elementary program on Tuesdays or Thursdays, 8:30AM-3:30PM. Both programs match the start and stop of the day in our upper school, so scheduling and drop-off and pick-up are easier for families using Bellevue Tutorial with students of all ages.

What Will My Student Experience at Go! Jr.?

The Go! Jr. day will seek to balance structure with enough flexibility to keep your young student enthused and engaged while also helping them develop social skills and learn the rhythms of a class day.

Typical schedule:

Go! Grow: An opening Bible Rally and short devotional with 1st-4th grade.

Circle Time: Ease into our day discussing the date, weather, and daily plan.

Go! Imagine: Our biggest emphasis of the day -- Exploring language arts enrichment using the popular “Five in a Row” unit study curriculum and associated children’s books.

Science, Numbers, and History connections will be made using the week’s Five in a Row teaching. Some or all of these subjects may be addressed during the morning segment.

Go! Rest: Tutor-led read aloud, quiet time, and rest after lunch.

Go! Create: Wake up our minds with a precursor to Go! Create (Art) in 1st – 4th Grade.

Go! Move: An end of the day time for fun, games, and early P.E. learning.
