



Course Title: High School Advanced Art

Description:

Students who have successfully completed the HS Introduction to Art class (or similar course) may now choose to continue their art studies with our Advanced Art class. Tutor approval required at class registration.

The advanced art student will continue working with the elements and principles of art while working with both 2-D and 3-D art projects. Students will be expected to spend several hours working in their sketchbooks each week. Creativity, planning, concentration, and an open mind to the world of art will be very important.

This course involves assembling a portfolio and learning to look more deeply at art – discussing various elements of a particular work and critiquing art pieces. Advanced art requires a serious investment of time and effort. The course is especially useful for students interested in applying to art schools or studying art in college.

A wide variety of art materials will be utilized. Classwork will also cover a variety of artists and their techniques.

Prerequisites: Successful completion of Intro to Art (or similar) and tutor approval.
