



Course Title: Japanese 2 (*1.0 high school credit*)

Description:

This course is designed for high school students seeking 1 credit of foreign language study. Your student will continue to learn vocabulary and grammar in the weekly class in order to equip them in their daily studies at home. They will become even more proficient in the written language of kanji. As in Japanese 1, students can expect to spend 45 – 60 minutes per day on homework. As culture is a big part of understanding the Japanese language and people, there will also be discussions regarding daily life, school, work, festivals and other relevant topics. By the end of their second year, students will be able to have meaningful conversations with native speakers in a variety of subjects and have a greater understanding of the culture.
