



Course Title: Physical Science

Description:

This course is designed for students seeking high school Physical Science. We will study general principles in chemistry, physics and Earth science including: the atmosphere, the hydrosphere, weather, the structure of the earth, the physics of motion, Newton's Laws, and gravity and other natural forces.

Homework will average 3-4 hours per week. Students learn scientific methods of making observations, recording data, analyzing results and drawing conclusions. Students will be prepared for biology or chemistry. They gain confidence in reading scientific explanations, solving problems, and performing experiments in a relaxed atmosphere.
