



Course Title: World History (1.0 high school credit)

Description:

Agreeing with the writer of Ecclesiastes when he states, “there is nothing new under the sun,” we examine the cycle that is world history. The focus of the world history class is “what did (a particular) civilization do with the time that God gave them?” There have been two groups that have struggled throughout the history of the world: the group that attempted to follow the truth of God, and the group that attempted to substitute some other philosophy in the place of God. Greek philosophy, humanism, socialism, totalitarianism – all have attempted to replace God with some alternative. We will examine these attempts and note their failures.

Students should plan for approximately 30 minutes of homework each day.
