



Bellevue Tutorial Study Hall

What is study hall?

Study Hall offers students a supervised location to read, complete homework, study for tests, and prepare for upcoming classes. It is available throughout the day for students who have a break between classes or for students with a sibling in class at a different hour. Students are expected to work quietly in the classroom and attendance will be taken. Food and drink are permitted as long as they do not disturb other students.

Who should be in study hall?

Any 5th through 12th grade student remaining at Bellevue during an “off-period” break or before or after their classes while waiting for a sibling to complete classes. Our extended break for lunch (11:40 AM – 12:20 PM) does not require study hall.

When and where is study hall offered?

Study hall is available during all hours of the tutorial on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The designated rooms will be indicated with signage.

What does the fee provide?

The \$180 fee provides access to the supervised study hall on both Tuesdays and Thursdays throughout the school year.

What is the electronic policy for study hall?

Use of handheld electronics (tablets and phones) is not allowed during Study Hall. Laptop computers and tablets when approved by the monitor may be used for academic purposes to complete schoolwork during study hall time.

Allowed:

- Laptops strictly for classwork.
- Headphones and earbuds.
- Snacks and drinks.
- Reading book.

Not Allowed:

- Handheld electronics including tablets, phones, and gaming devices.

Is study hall registration required?

Students on campus, but not in class must be in study hall during classtime. If a student needs to come early or stay late on occasion (ex: staying after school for a meeting or party) they may attend study hall even if they are not registered. If a student will be on campus on a regular basis, while not in class, they need to be registered for study hall.

Why can my student not sit in the lobby?

In order to ensure the safety and protection of our students, they are expected to remain in the Tutorial hallways during class time hours.
