



Course Title: Consumer Math

Description:

This course is a 3rd or 4th high school year math course designed for students who need an additional math credit prior to graduation. Consumer Math targets high school juniors and seniors that have completed high school math through Algebra 2 but are not yet ready to step into Precalculus or are on a high school track that does not require precalculus. Consumer Math will provide the opportunity for students to use mathematical reasoning to solve real-life problems and increase mathematical confidence through in-depth study. The focus is on applying math skills to real world situations while digging deeper into core mathematic skills prior to further study beyond high school.

Preferred Completion: Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2
