



Course Title: Japanese 1 (*1.0 high school credit*)

Description:

This course is designed for high school students seeking 1 credit of foreign language study. Your student will learn both the oral and written languages of Japanese through partner or group activities, games, and coursework. The weekly tutorial class will focus on grammar and vocabulary as well as instructions on how to write the Japanese characters in order to equip the student to continue their daily studies at home. As culture is a big part of understanding the Japanese language and people, there will also be discussions regarding daily life, school, work, and other interesting topics. By the end of the course, your student will be able to carry on meaningful conversations with native speakers in a variety of subjects.
