Go! Create – Art:

Children love to create. In Go! Create students will find encouragement and instruction to express to the world the creations in their mind. Young students will learn the basics of drawing what they see and be introduced to the basic concepts of art to produce a lifelike drawing. Young students will also learn an overview of art styles and great artists from a historical perspective and study their work to inform our in-class projects.

Go! Examine – STEM:

Labs, puzzles, science challenges, and mysterious phenomena make science and STEM class a favorite for the young student. In Go! Examine STEM class students will start to explore creative thinking, problem solving, and team projects. We will develop and apply skills in science, technology, engineering, and math to create and solve each “weekly mission.” Exercising critical thinking skills, we will design the best solutions for each challenge and always work together to complete it.

Go! Explore – History:

History is full of amazing tales and harrowing feats just waiting for us to explore them. Go! Explore uses the popular and proven Story of the World history series to dive into an amazing world of historical people and events. Students will explore history and time periods through read aloud books, activities, games, and projects. Geography, maps, and timelines will also be introduced.

Go! Measure – Math Madness:

Math is loaded with opportunities for games and fun activities. From games to puzzles and beyond we will explore relevant mathematical concepts such as number lines, addition, subtraction, place value, measurement, time, basic probability identification, skip counting, and geometry concepts. We will play math games, use music and manipulatives, and have fun with many hands-on activities.

Go! Imagine – IEW Composition:

In Go! Imagine 3rd and 4th grade students will be introduced to beginner-level writing. Students will learn how to read source texts, identify important information, write key word outlines, and transfer the key outlines into their own writing. Writing will be enhanced by learning to eliminate banned words and add dress-ups, sentence openers, vocabulary words and decorations. Students will be taught paragraph editing, and there will be some grammar instruction.

Go! Move – Physical Education:

Our physical bodies are a wonderful creation of God, and young bodies love to get out and move. In Go! Move we will learn about and drill a wide variety of games, sports, and other activities that we can experience through physical movement. Students will utilize age appropriate fitness activities including tumbling, simple games/relays, sport skills and other activities.
