



Course Title: Computer Discovery

Description:

A computer offers a seemingly endless palate to enable students to create and explore. This 32-week introductory course empowers students to engage with computers and technology as a medium for creativity, communication, problem solving, and fun.

We will learn the basics about the computer as a machine and the typical employment of computers for email, word processing, and data entry. Additionally, we will explore computer coding with block coding and modern computing topics like digital citizenship and computer ethics.

Prerequisites: Grades 6 through 8 and adequate keyboarding skills highly recommended.
