

Course Title: Middle School Art

Description:

The Middle School Art class is the perfect opportunity for the student that wants to explore the many areas of the visual arts! A wide variety of art materials will be emphasized, as well as artists and their techniques. The fundamentals of a strong work of art will be examined in the context of discussions about the *elements of art/design* and the *principles of art/design*. The elements we will study are: line, shape, form, texture, space, color, and value. The principles we will study are: balance (symmetrical/asymmetrical), proportion, unity, harmony, variety, emphasis, rhythm, and movement using pencil, colored pencil, acrylics and watercolor.
