Matthew 28:16–20; Acts 1:1–11

ASK interactive questions.

1. Where would you go if you could travel to any country in the world? Why?
2. The Bible says that some people still doubted Jesus when they saw Him after His resurrection. Why do you think they doubted?
3. Jesus commanded us to tell other people about Him. How can we do that as a family?

BRING your understanding.

Share one thing you learned about the Great Commission from your adult Life Group lesson.

CREATE fun experiences.

Activity: Go!

Supplies: Various items in your house

Gather your family in the most central point of your home. Tell them you will give them several instructions that start with the word “go,” and they will have 30 seconds to complete each task.

Possible instructions to give during the activity:

- Go...and get your toothbrush.
- Go...and clean your room.
- Go...and get your favorite toy.
- Go...and get a red shirt.

At the end of the activity, tell your family that Jesus told us to “*Go and make disciples.*” Just as your family followed your instructions during the activity, everyone must follow Jesus’ instructions to tell others about Him.
