Activity: Dinner Together

Supplies: Food and supplies to make a meal

Invite another family from our church over for a meal. Be sure to plan time for your families to play a game together and get to know each other better.

Five Get-To-Know-You Questions:

1. What is the furthest you have ever traveled from home? Where did you go?
2. What are your favorite things to do together as a family?
3. What is something you love about your neighborhood?
4. What is one thing you enjoy about being involved at Bellevue?
5. What are your favorite books to read or movies to watch?

During the meal, discuss how each family can pray for the other. At the end of the meal, read Acts 2:46–47 and help your children understand that being hospitable to other Christians is one way they can be like the early church.
