

**Week of March 19: Jesus Calls the Disciples**  
**Matthew 4:18–25**

**ASK interactive questions.**

1. Why do you think each of the men obeyed Jesus' command to follow Him?
2. If someone told you they served God with their whole life, what would you imagine they did each day?
3. What are different ways people can tell others about Jesus?

**BRING your understanding.**

Share one thing you learned about Jesus calling the disciples from your adult Life Group lesson.

**CREATE fun experiences.**

Activity: Paper-Plate Pictures

Supplies: Paper plates and crayons

Give each family member a paper plate and a crayon. Tell everyone to place the paper plate on top of their heads and follow your instructions to draw a picture.

Possible instructions you can give to draw a house:

- Draw some grass.
- Draw a house with a roof.
- Draw a door in the middle of the house.
- Draw several windows on the house.
- Draw a chimney on the roof with smoke coming out.
- Draw a tree to the right of the house.
- Draw our family on the left side of the house.

Have everyone take their plates off their heads and compare pictures. Most likely, everyone's pictures will be jumbled messes. Explain to your family that following God's instructions to minister to other people can be hard, and sometimes, you won't get it right. However, it's OK when you mess up because you are obeying God's instructions to serve other people. The disciples didn't always get it right, but Jesus continued to teach them how to minister to other people.
