1. In your own words, tell me what happened to Joseph in Egypt.
2. If you were Joseph, how would you have responded to your brothers when they showed up, needing food?
3. The Bible says God was with Joseph during everything he experienced in Egypt. How can we know that God is with us today?

Activity: Forgiveness Practice

Supplies: Notecards and pens

Begin by writing different scenarios where someone wrongs someone else on notecards. Personalize the scenarios so that each family member is named. Then, place all the cards in a cup. Tell your family that when you draw a scenario out of the cup, the first person named will say, "I'm sorry; will you forgive me?" And the other person will respond with, "I forgive you."

Be sure to write scenarios that your family has dealt with before, but include some silly scenarios as well.

Possible scenarios:

- Dad thought Johnny disobeyed Mom's directions and gave him a consequence. However, Dad found out later that it was Susan who disobeyed mom.
- Hunter played with the paint can while mom was painting the dining room, and he dumped the can onto the floor.
- Kim went into Timmy's room and took his favorite Avengers pencil so she could do her homework.
- Mom yelled at Chloe because she accidentally dropped her bowl on the floor.
