CREATE fun experiences.

Activity: Fish of Forgiveness

Supplies: Construction paper, scissors, and crayons

Give each family member a piece of construction paper and crayons. Instruct them to draw, color, and decorate a fish on their paper. Next, help them cut out their fish. After cutting the fish out, tell them to write 1 John 1:9 on the back of their fish.

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9

Remind your family that no matter what they have done, God always forgives them when they repent and turn back to Him.
