

**Week of May 21: Saul's Conversion**  
**Acts 9:1–20**

**ASK interactive questions.**

1. How does Jesus speak to us today?
2. Why was Ananias scared to obey God's instruction to go to Saul? How would you have responded if you were Ananias?
3. What happened after Ananias obeyed God? Why is it important to obey God even when you're scared?

**BRING your understanding.**

Share one thing you learned about Saul becoming a Christian from your adult Life Group lesson.

**CREATE fun experiences.**

Activity: Transforming Bricks

Supplies: A set of interlocking bricks

Pour the interlocking bricks into a pile in the middle of the room. Instruct your family members to create an object or structure of their choosing with the bricks. After everyone has built something, allow each person to share what they made. Next, instruct everyone to disassemble their creations and build something new, using the same bricks they used the first time. After everyone has a new creation, allow each person to share what their original creation transformed into.

Tell your family that after Saul encountered Jesus, he transformed into an entirely different man. Before his encounter, Saul hated Jesus and His followers. After the encounter, he loved Jesus and told everyone how they could be saved by following Him.
