Acts 6:1–10

ASK interactive questions.

1. What is the biggest problem you've ever faced? How did you solve it?
2. What is a problem in our city that you think our church needs to help with?
3. Why is it important for kids in our church to serve other people?

BRING your understanding.

Share one thing you learned about the church serving others from your adult Life Group lesson.

CREATE fun experiences.

Activity: Family Juggling

Supplies: Objects you can toss

Instruct your family to stand in a circle, facing each other. Pick up a ball (or another small object), and tell your family to determine the order of which you will all toss the ball to each other (e.g., you will toss the ball to person #2, who will toss it to person #3, and so on). Toss the ball around the circle in that order several times. Then, as you continue to toss the first ball around to each other, introduce a second ball into the circle, and keep both balls going around the circle in the pre-determined order. After your family masters juggling two balls, attempt to introduce a third ball and a fourth ball.

After you finish this activity, ask your family two questions: 1) What challenges did we face in this activity? 2) How did we solve those challenges?

Tell your family that the early church faced a problem, trying to provide food for all the widows in their church. Because they were willing to work together, they were able to solve the problem so that everyone could have food.
