Activity: Mirror Prayers

Supplies: A dry-erase marker and a bathroom mirror

Gather your family together, and tell them they will each pick three people or situations to pray for throughout the week. Give each person a dry-erase marker, and tell them to write their prayer topics on their bathroom mirror. After each person has written their topics on their mirror, pray for each topic together as a family. Instruct your family to pray for these topics in the morning as they get ready for the day and at night as they get ready for bed. Remind them that God hears their prayers.
