Activity: Frog Relay Race

Supplies: None

Gather your family in the largest room of your house. Form two teams with your family members. Tell everyone they will compete in a frog relay race, in which they will hop like a frog to the other side of the room and back. One person from each team will start; once they get back, the next teammate from each team must do the same. The team that has everyone hop back and forth the quickest is the winner! Remind your family that an infestation of frogs was the second plague God used to show His power to the Egyptians.
