Activity: Exodus Obstacle Course

Supplies: A large stick and objects from around your house

Before the activity, gather objects from around your home and set up an obstacle course. Include items to jump over, items to climb through, or items to crawl under. Tell your family to pretend they are leading the Israelites out of Egypt, and they have to go through the obstacle course as quickly as possible. As each person starts the obstacle course, give them a large stick to carry with them to represent Moses holding his staff. The person who completes the course the fastest is the winner! Remind your family that God is always faithful, even when the circumstances are scary and difficult.
