Activity: 10 Commandments Charades

Supplies: Note cards, a pen, and a large cup

Before the activity, write each of the 10 Commandments on a note card, and place all the note cards in a large cup. Explain to your family that one person will start by pulling out a card that contains one of the 10 Commandments. They will have 30 seconds to act out the commandment without using words so the other family members can guess the commandment. Whoever guesses the commandment correctly gets a point. Let each family member have a turn, and continue until all the commandments have been acted out. Whoever has the most points at the end is the winner!
