Exodus 3:1–15

ASK interactive questions.

1. How would you respond if you were to come across a burning bush that talked to you?
2. Why do you think God called Moses to lead His people out of Egypt?
3. What kept Moses from wanting to obey God? How can we encourage each other to obey God's directions?

BRING your understanding.

CREATE fun experiences.

Activity: Dramatic Reading

Supplies: Bible

Turn to Exodus 3 in your Bible. Tell your family that they will dramatically act out the events of Exodus 3:1–15. Choose one person to represent Moses and someone else to play God. Encourage “Moses” and “God” to be creative as they act out their parts while you read the story. Allow each of your family members to have turns to play both Moses and God. Afterward, remind your family that God promises to help them wherever He will send them in the future.
