- 3. When we're in the middle of a difficult time, how can we show our trust in Jesus?

Activity: Paper Boat Race

Supplies: Paper, water, a bathtub, and a timer

Give everyone a piece of paper, and watch this video to learn how to make a paper boat: youtu.be/3N7EUi3-PG8. After everyone has made their boat, fill your bathtub with water. As the tub is filling up, tell your family that they are going to compete in a paper boat race by blowing their boats the length of the tub. Whoever blows their boat across the tub the fastest is the winner.

Remind your family that even though the storm threatened the boat, the disciples were safe because they were with Jesus.
