Activity: Scripture Comic Strip

Supplies: Paper and pencils

Give each family member a piece of paper and a pencil. Instruct them to turn their papers horizontally and draw two rows of three equal-sized boxes. The boxes need to be as large as the paper will allow. Tell everyone to draw a comic strip of the events from John 11:1-45. Encourage them to draw speech bubbles, dialogue, and captions. After everyone has finished, allow each person to share their comic strip with the family.
