CREATE fun experiences.

Activity: Full Heart

Supplies: Red construction paper and markers

Give each family member a piece of red construction paper and some markers. Instruct them to draw a large heart on their papers. Next, tell them to draw a picture inside the heart of a way they can show their hearts are fully committed to God. After all the pictures are finished, give each person the opportunity to show their hearts and explain their pictures to the rest of the family.

Finish this activity by reading 1 Samuel 16:7, and encourage your family to give their whole hearts to the Lord.
