Activity: Mystery Items

Supplies: A paper lunch sack and various items that represent the sea

Before beginning this activity, find various items or toys that represent the sea, and place them in the paper lunch sack. Tell your family that they will each reach into the sack and, without looking, grab one item. They must guess what the item is before they pull it out. If they guess correctly, they get a point. Allow everyone to take turns until all the items have been pulled out. Whoever has the most points at the end of the activity is the winner. Remind your family that Jonah was stuck in the sea because he disobeyed God's Word. Encourage everyone to obey God and follow His ways!
