Activity: Giant Feet

Supplies: White paper, tape, and markers

Give every family member two pieces of paper. Instruct them to tape the bottom of one piece of paper to the top of the other piece. Then, tell them to draw a giant foot that spans both pieces of paper. Direct them to write this week’s memory verse, 1 Samuel 17:47, on the foot. Next, tell them to decorate the foot however they want. Allow each person to show off their decorated foot. Afterward, read 1 Samuel 17:47 to your family, and remind them that God fights for them whenever they face difficult circumstances.
