



Course Title: Anatomy & Physiology

Description:

This 32-week advanced biology course provides the student the opportunity to gain knowledge and a deeper understanding of the human body's structure and systems. Areas of study include: cell structure, skeletal structures, nervous system, endocrine glands, muscular system, heart and circulatory system, immune system, respiratory system, urinary system, digestive system, and the reproductive system. Taught with technical expertise and from a Christian worldview, this class will help prepare students interested in biomedical, nursing, and other health-related careers. In-class dissections will be used for hands-on anatomical study.
