How To Choose a Bible or Reading Plan

The following questions can help you create realistic and achievable expectations.

How much time do you want to spend reading the Bible each day?

Duration can affect the time of day you read, the reading plan you select, and additional resources you use.

What is the best time of day for you to read the Bible?

It's good to begin the day with God's Word, but there are periods of life when that isn't feasible. So find a time that works for you. And remember—the more consistent you can be, the more likely you will stick to your plan.

How many chapters do you want to read in a day?

You can read several chapters each day to finish the Bible within a certain time frame, or you can read smaller portions and spend more time meditating on Scripture.

Do you prefer a more in-depth Bible study, or do you prefer to simply read and reflect?

You may choose to include resources such as podcasts, workbooks, or videos in your study plan. Those choices will affect your time commitment and the amount of Scripture you read each day.
