Homeschool Choir | \$275 (30 weeks)

Grades 7–12 | Tuesdays | 3:40–5:00 p.m.

The 7th–12th grade Homeschool Choir performs fun and engaging music that includes genres such as traditional choral literature, African pieces, foreign language pieces, movie and Broadway music, hymn arrangements, and contemporary Christian arrangements. Students are taught to read music, hear and sing harmonies, sing with proper technique, understand basic music theory, sing with musicianship, and much more. Classes are 80 minutes long with a snack break in the middle. The 7th–12th grade Homeschool Choir joins the Children's Choir for a performance at the end of each semester.

Students who are enrolled in the Bellevue Homeschool Choir and maintain an attendance record of at least 75 percent will be eligible for West Tennessee Vocal Music Educators Association events, such as All West, All State, and Solo and Ensemble.

The Homeschool Children's Choir learns an eclectic array of fun music designed to teach children how to read music, sing on pitch, sing with proper technique, harmonize, keep rhythm, and so much more. Lisa makes class fun and picks songs the kids love to sing. Classes are 80 minutes long with a snack break in the middle. The Children's Choir joins the 7th–12th grade Homeschool Choir for a performance at the end of each semester.

Beginner Piano Class | \$350 (30 weeks)

Grades 6–8 | Thursdays | 3:45–4:30 p.m.

Students will learn the basics of playing piano in a classroom setting. They will learn skills like learning to read music, understand basic music theory, playing by ear, and playing beginner level songs. Each student will have their own keyboard in class. It is helpful if students have a keyboard or piano at home for practicing.
