

SEND OUT TRAINING EXPECTATIONS:

Attendance:

All participants are expected to attend all class meetings, both on Sunday and weekdays.

- If you cannot make it to **any** of the scheduled events, it is **your responsibility** to communicate that to the Send Out Training (SOT) leadership team **both verbally and in written form as soon as possible.**
 - If you miss more than **2** scheduled events/classes, you are not eligible to receive any of the privileges or funding that come from graduating SOT. You can apply to retake SOT another semester, but *acceptance is not guaranteed*. Please ensure you are available during the semester for which you are applying to participate in SOT training.
 - Additional Sessions:
 - Participants are required to attend 2 Local Service Opportunities, 2 Sunday Morning Sessions, and 1 Movie Night Breakout
 - If there are duplicate breakout sessions, *you are required to attend **one** of the two options per breakout session.*
- Additionally, participants are expected to **come on time, answer questions, and interact with the class.**
 - **Participation is the expectation, not just attendance.**

Google Classroom:

*Students are expected to complete **all** assigned coursework in Google Classroom.*

- All topics in SOT will include a module with short weekly readings and assignments. **These readings and classwork must be completed by Saturday night before the topic is discussed in class on Sunday.**
- After the deadline, assignments will close and can only be reopened by contacting a member of the SOT leadership team. Additionally, assignments for each week will only become available **after the previous topic has been covered in Sunday's class.**
- If you have any difficulty or problems with anything concerning Google Classroom, please don't hesitate to reach out! Our leadership team will try to get back to you by the next business day, so please don't wait until the last minute.

Readings:

- Each participant will be provided a physical copy of the *Master Plan of Evangelism* when approved to be in SOT. **This book and all pertaining coursework should be finished by the 1st week of Send Out Training.**

- Each participant will also be provided with a physical copy of **Foundations** by the *IMB*. These resources will be read as you complete the course with weekly check-in assignments that go along with the topics that are being taught in class.



Evangelism Accounts & Abiding Accounts:

- Evangelism:
 - Each participant is expected to share the Gospel three times throughout the 10 weeks that SOT runs. The expectation is that you share at least once every three weeks!
 - This will be checked through your Abide Section in the Google Classroom.
- Abiding Section:
 - Each week, students will complete an abiding check-in. This includes reflecting on spiritual disciplines, evangelism, and discipleship. The purpose of this check-in is to encourage intentional growth and provide accountability throughout the program. Students are expected to be actively engaged in the missionary task throughout the week.
