

**Course Title: Computer Science Discoveries****Description:**

A computer offers a seemingly endless palate to enable students to create and explore. This 32-week introductory course empowers students to engage with computer science as a medium for creativity, communication, problem solving, and fun.

Topics covered will be scratch coding, graphic design, typing proficiency, and computer programming. This course inspires students as they build their own websites, apps, games, and graphic designs. This course will be the first steps in computer science readiness.

Prerequisites: Grades 8 through 10 and adequate keyboarding skills highly recommended.
