

# BE A TENTMAKER

Paul was a traveling missionary. On one of his travels he met Aquila and Priscilla. They were Christians and tentmakers just like Paul. Paul stayed with Aquila and Priscilla making tents, worshipping, and telling others about Jesus.

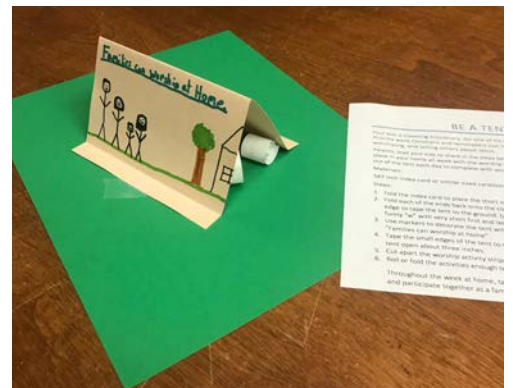
Parents, lead your kids to make a small tent. Keep this in a prominent place in your home all week with the worship activities housed inside. Choose a worship activity out of the tent each day to complete with your children.

Materials:

5X7 inch index card or similar sized cardstock, 1 sheet of paper, tape, markers, scissors

Steps:

1. Fold the index card to place the short sides together.
2. Fold each of the ends back onto the collapsed tent to make an edge to tape the tent to the ground. (you've "w" with very short first and last legs.
3. Use markers to decorate the tent with pictures or a phrase like "Families can worship at home"
4. Tape the small edges of the tent to the piece of paper with the tent open about three inches.
5. Cut apart the worship activity strips at the bottom of this sheet.
6. Roll or fold the activities enough to place each separately inside the tent.



Throughout the week at home, take turns drawing family worship activities out of the tent and participate together as a family.
