

**Course Title: Algebra 1****Description:**

This course is designed for students who have completed pre-algebra and will provide the first high school math credit. Topics covered will include working with real numbers, solving equations and problems, polynomials, factoring, fractions, linear equations, inequalities, introduction to functions, and rational and irrational numbers. Upon completion of this course, students will be prepared to advance to either geometry or algebra 2.
