



Course Title: Geography

Description:

This course is designed for 9th and 10th grade students seeking one credit for high school social studies. Students will broadly survey geographic principles through a regional approach. Beginning in North America, we will "travel" from continent to continent around the world studying the geography, cultures, land forms, climates, resources, economy, religions, and government of each country. Students will take a "virtual world tour" that will provide an engaging exploration of world geography and culture. Their study will culminate in a World's Fair held in April.
