Course Title: Government / Economics

Description:

1st Semester: Government

This course will provide 0.5 credit for high school U.S government for graduation. The course will include a Christian perspective on government in the United States and the principles and mechanics of a constitutional republic. Topics of discussion include the Constitution, the three branches of government, political parties, elections and foreign policy.

2nd Semester: Economics

This course will provide 0.5 credit for high school economics for graduation. The curriculum will cover basic economics, economic philosophy and policy. Students will learn about a variety of topics including supply & demand, money, banking, budgeting and governmental role in the economy. This course will not fulfill the separate Personal Finance requirement for high school students.
