

**Course Title: U.S. History****Description:**

This 32-week course will provide 1.0 high school credit for social studies in U.S. History. Students will explore the history and chronological story of the United States from its discovery and inception up to the present day. We will discuss the key decisions and issues in our nation's history and the impact on the American people and our neighbors in the world. Students will benefit from a range of assignments to provide for additional research in areas of interest, map work, and time-lining.
