

# Faith Talk

## I Engage in Local Witnessing Opportunities

*"You will be my witnesses." Acts 1:8*

### Things you'll need:

- Make a list of 10 places you have been recently (a downloadable chart is available at [bellevue.org/homepoint](http://bellevue.org/homepoint))
- Roll of masking tape or sidewalk chalk

### Faith Talk:

When we tell others what we know about Jesus, we show that we love God and love people. The following activities will help your family understand the many opportunities we have to tell others about Jesus.

Play a guessing game with your family using your list of 10 places. Describe clues for each location until a family member guesses the place. For example, if the location is a "park", then the clues could be: swing set, feeding ducks, slide, etc.

After each location is guessed, list people you see while at that location. The list may include close friends, family, acquaintances or people you have not yet met. Continue for each location and consider how many people your family comes in contact with each week!

Next, take the masking tape (or sidewalk chalk if playing outside) and create a hopscotch design; however, shape the first box to look like a house.

In Acts 1:8, Jesus says that we will be His witnesses.

What is a witness? A witness is someone who tells what he knows to be true or what he has seen.

Before playing hopscotch, discuss how sharing Jesus starts in your home and you move outward (through the grid) from there. When you leave home, you have opportunities to share Jesus with people almost every time. Label each hopscotch box with a location from your list.

Before each person's hopscotch turn, he should list 3 things: a location, a person at that location, and a truth about Jesus (ex. soccer practice, teammate Mark, Jesus helps me not to be afraid). You can follow general hopscotch rules or make up your own.

How can you be His witness? Tell the truths you know about Jesus to other people.
