A. Judgment for [Christians](#):

- 1) Doesn't [determine](#) eternal destiny. *1 John 5:12*
- 2) The Christian's [works](#) are judged. *2 Cor. 5:10*
- 3) Results in [rewards](#) or [loss](#) of rewards. *1 Cor. 3:11–15*

B. Judgment for [Non-Christians](#). *Rev. 20:11–15*

3. We spend eternity in [Heaven](#) or [Hell](#). *Luke 16:22–23*

[Purgatory](#) and [reincarnation](#) aren't mentioned in Scripture.

A. Eternity for the [Christian](#).

- 1) At death—[Paradise](#). *Luke 16:22; 2 Cor. 5:8*
- 2) End of time—[New Jerusalem](#). *Matt. 25:31–34; Rev. 21:1–8*

B. Eternity for the [Non-Christian](#).

- 1) At death—[Hades](#).
 - They continue to [see](#). *Luke 16:23*
 - They continue to [speak](#). *Luke:24a*
 - They continue to [feel](#). *Luke 16:24*
 - They continue to [remember](#). *Luke 16:25*
 - They continue to be [concerned](#). *Luke 16:27–28*

2) At the end of time—the [lake](#) of [fire](#) ([Gehenna](#)).
